### **Matchday information for visiting teams – 2026/27**

Dear Club representatives,

On behalf of Christleton Football Club, our warmest welcome to Little Heath. We wish to make your visit enjoyable and safe. To enable this, we draw your attention to the following points:

- Children are very welcome to our facility. However, children are NOT permitted inside the dressing room area, in the dugout or on the pitch side of the barrier on match days.
- A defibrillator is available for use in Emergency situations; it is located on the exterior of the garage wall under the Ken Price Stand. Please allocate a person within your party to retrieve the Defibrillator in the event of an emergency. Please ensure you call 999 before obtaining the Defibrillator. - Dogs are allowed at Little however we ask that they remain on a lead, and any dog mess is cleaned by the owner and disposed of in the bin outside the entrance to the ground adjacent to the bike track.
- There are fire extinguishers around the venue. Should the fire evacuation alarm sound, the meeting point is the main car park to the front of the club. Be aware that no fire safety or evacuation drills will be planned or carried out on matchdays.
- Parking is available on site at our ground, to the front of the club as well as an overflow carpark at the far end of the club – this is adequately signposted. There is additional parking on the grass verge of the approach lane to the club, adjacent to the parish playing field. Please park considerately.
- We ask that all club officials, players and supporters to behave in an acceptable and appropriate manner.
- Hot/cold beverages and alcohol are served in the club house at Little Heath. Guests are not permitted to bring or consume alcohol not bought from the clubhouse. We ask that all bottles, cans and general rubbish are disposed in the bins provided inside and outside the clubhouse.
- Please leave the changing room & dugout areas clean and tidy, bins are provided for use.
- Smoking is permitted at uncovered areas around the ground; however, we ask that all cigarette ends are disposed of appropriately.
- All accidents, incidents and near misses should be reported to Christleton FC officers immediately.

- Be aware that images/ videos may be taken by club officials for use on club website and social media pages, should you have any objections to this then please speak with club officials prior to the game, should no objections be made at this point then consent is implied.
- Should your team have any players under the age of 18 then please inform club officials prior to the game.
- This venue uses Veo automated camera systems to record football matches and training sessions for performance analysis, coaching, and safeguarding purposes.
  - By entering Christleton FC grounds, you acknowledge that:
    - Video footage may be recorded in which you may appear
    - Recording is carried out in the legitimate interests of Christleton Football Club
    - Footage may be shared, where appropriate, with players, coaches, match officials, league organisers, and The Football Association
  - Christleton Football Club is committed to safeguarding children and adults at risk. Recording is used to support a safe sporting environment and to assist with the review of incidents if required.
  - All footage is processed in accordance with UK GDPR and FA safeguarding guidance, and is securely stored by our appointed processor (Veo Technologies).
